GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Sealed Tenders are invited reputed Decorators/Contractors/Fabricators for Interior /Exterior Decoration, Fabrication of Rack & Counter, Front Gate and Electrification Work for the proposed Special Handloom Expo to be held at Neelachal Urban Haat, C.T Road, Puri from 21/12/2011 to 04/01/2012.

2. The duration of Expo shall be 15 (fifteen) days. However, in case it is extended up to 3 (three) days, no extra payment shall be made to the Contractors. In case the Fair extended for more than three days extra payment for each extended days(s) beyond 18 days shall be made at the rate not exceeding proportionate cost for 18 days. On completion of the Expo, the Contractor shall have to take away all the materials within 3 (three) days and shall have to vacate the site. He shall have to pay 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand) only per day for the days he occupies for vacating the site beyond the period allowed therefore. It is the responsibilities of the Contractor to obtain clearance certificate from the Complex Authorities regarding clearance of the complex.

3. The expo premises shall be formally made available to the Contractor by Expo Authority on, as is where is basis on 16th December 2011. The construction work must start immediately at site on the same day and be completed and handed over to the expo Authorities formally by 5.00 P.M. on 20th December 2011 positively. The progress of the work shall be checked and supervised by officers duly nominated by the Expo Authority to ensure that the work is done as per the specifications and time schedule. Tenderers are advised to inspect the site for physical condition before tendering.

4. In case any portion of work is not completed as per laid down specifications and handed over to the Expo Authorities on the due date, penalty up to 5% on the total value of work allotted/awarded will be imposed per day by the Expo Authorities.

5. The volume and number of works may vary at discretion of the Expo Authority, up to 40% of the contracted work either way & final payment to the contractor shall be regulated on the basis of actual work executed and on the rate(s) initially approved. For extra fittings contractor will have to quote rate separately. For all such extra fittings, the Expo Authority reserves the right to pay the lowest of the rates quoted by the competing Contractor.

6. The Contractor will be responsible for up keep and maintenance of the entire work done by him till the closing of the exhibition, for which, no extra payments shall be made. He shall therefore, have to ensure adequate number of carpenters/helpers to the satisfaction of the Expo Authority. Breakages and damages in any work shall immediately be settled and no extra payment will be made for any damage, breakage or loss on account of any reason or natural calamities. Lay out plans etc of the site shall have to be provided by the tenderers. Managing Director, Orissa State Handloom Weavers' Co-operative Society ltd, Bhubaneswar reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason or to accept any portion of the tender and award the remaining work to any other Contractor.

7. No part of the contract will be sub-let without the prior written permission of the Managing Director, Orissa State Handloom Weavers' Co-operative Society Ltd./Expo Authority.

8. It shall be the responsibility of the successful tenderers/contractor to obtain requisite permission for water, electricity power, coverage and other essential connection at the Expo Ground for the duration of the Expo i.e. from the date the ground is handed over to the contractor for construction to the date the ground is handed over back to the Local Authority from whom it has been taken on rent. It shall also be responsibility of the contractor to liaise with the concerned authorities and arrange all the civil, electrical connection and other amenities that may be required for running of the Expo. However, security deposits, if required, shall be made by the Expo Authority. Letters to the concerned authorities shall also be addressed by the Expo Authority. Security deposits, installation charges and consumption charges for all civil and electrical connections for the duration of the Expo while shall be paid by the Expo Authority, the contractor will however, have to pay all security deposits, installation & consumption charges, both civil and electrical for the duration he takes over the ground to the time he formally hands over the complete work of the Expo to the Expo Authority.

9. In regard to electrical fittings etc, the contractor shall have to engage qualified licensed Electrician/Contractor entitled to erect, handle and maintain high tension supply line and its up keep and maintenance.

10. The contractor shall not use any materials other than those specified in tender without the prior permission of the Managing Director, Orissa State Handloom Weavers' Co-operative Society Ltd., Bhubaneswar/Expo Authority.

11. No advance shall be paid to the contractor till completion of the work and handing over to the Expo Authorities, but part payment may be considered to the contractor during the Expo on mutual agreed upon between the contractor and Expo Authority. Final payments will be made only after completion of the Expo and handing over the complex to the Complex Authorities.

12. All the tenderers should fill the rate tendered in figures as well as in words. The tender form may be filled in English and all entries made by hand and written in ink. Over writings in rate is not permitted. All corrections should be attested by the tenderers with his initials as many times as corrections occur. Each page of the Tender Form and other related papers submitted there- with should be signed by the tenderers. Any discrepancy in the rates written in figures and words, then the rates written in word is final. Similarly discrepancy in the rates quoted for unit rate and total amount, then the rate quoted for unit is final. The Tenderers are required to inspect the site prior to quoting their rates.

13. The Tenderers are required to deposit an earnest/security money of Rs.1,00,000.00 (Rupees one lakh) only.  - ii. Pan No., Income Tax, Sales Tax/VAT Clearance Certificate etc along with latest service tax deposit chalan as required for the Tender process.
 - iii. Proof of financial status and credit worthiness of the firm from any scheduled bank, indicating the financial capacity of the party to complete the work without any advance.
 - iv. A list of works of similar nature executed given details of their magnitude, cost and time within which works were completed.
 - v. Copy of valid registration, ITCC, STC/VAT, Service Tax Certificates from concerned authorities.
 - vi. The Tenderers shall have to furnish the License of the Electrical contractor to entitle to take up such work along with his willingness.
 - vii. The Tenderers shall have to furnish the willingness of a registered Security Agency along with their Registration Certificate and other required documents.

STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR THE INTERIOR AND EXTERIOR DECORATION WORK OF THE EXHIBITION PAVILIONS/STALL FOR SPECIAL HANDLOOM EXPO.

DETAILED SPECIFICATIONS

The interior/exterior work should be neatly finished. The folded type three-tier Storage Rack is to be fabricated with 32 mm dia M.S Pipes joint with 25 x 5 mm flat for leg, rack plate with 1 inch square pipe joint with 25 X 5 mm flat covering with 9 mm Ply of size 10 Ft. x 1 Ft. supported by five / six legs. Each stall of Neelachal Urban Haat is to be furnished with one set of such storage rack i.e. 10 Ft. length of 4'6" height with 1st step at 2'6", 2nd in 3'6" and 3rd at 4'6" with 1' width shelf covering with new cloth.

Sale Counter & Cash Counter is to be fabricated with 1 inch dia square pipe with 19x8 flat joint top frame with 25x5 angle covering with 20 gauge iron sheet of size 8 ft. length, 1'6" width and 2'6" height. Each stall of Neelachal Urban Haat is to be furnished with one no. of such counter covering with new cloth.

Two nos. Decorative Entrance Gate are to be fabricated with wooden frame work and covering with approved design flex/handloom clothes as per drawing attached with tender papers as reference. Similarly one display gate to be erected in front road of the Neelachal Urban Haat, Puri towards youth Hostel.

For each Stall, two nos. of Fire Bucket to be provided by the Decorator.

All Electrical works including fitting & fixtures and wiring must be done through a licensed Electrical Contractor borne in the current approved list of Govt. Electrical Authority, who will submit and obtain the necessary approval necessary approvals and submit test form to Electrical Inspector, Govt. of Orissa for Power connection.

Besides existing lighting arrangement, the Contractor shall have to provide Halogen / Metal Halide / CFL Light etc if felt required.

A temporary shamyana with proper stage and dais should be provided with 15 nos. of new decorative/ attractive sofa, 25 nos. Executive Chairs with cost of white Turkish Towels and 200 nos. Chairs, one attractive Podium etc., for the Inaugural/Closing Function and Seminar/Work shop/Buyer-Sellers meet.

The decorators are required to provide furniture fixtures to Expo office, which include minimum one Sofa set, one Executive Table with six nos. of Executive Chairs, Jug, Mug, Flask, Glass, Cup Plate and other stationery as necessary for the Expo office.

The above specification are the minimum requirements. Further instructions on the spot will be given by the Expo Authority in case any deviation is deemed necessary. No extra payment shall be made to the contractor for all such addition / alterations.
